The Executive Doctorate in Business Administration (EDBA) at DePaul is designed for high potential executives who seek to take their careers to the next level. This distinctive degree will empower you to transform your organization through a mastery of sophisticated applied research for addressing contemporary business issues.

Candidates for the EDBA will learn to frame complex business problems in a manner that enables applied, evidence-based analysis of all available data and rigorous evaluation of potential solutions. EDBA graduates will have gained advanced insights into the latest research on organizational change and behavior to enhance their abilities to implement desired solutions and motivate action within their organizations.

This three-year, part-time program is for the working executive who has earned a previous master's degree in a business or business-related discipline. The ideal candidate will enter the program with significant business acumen gained through eight to 10 years of managerial or consultative experience.

Launch DePaul offers students the opportunity to submit and pitch a new business idea. Teams compete for a pool of \$17,000 in cash and additional awards of in-kind services.
